



SAN DIEGO CHINESE WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2022

SECTION I - GENERAL INFORMATION

Scholarships will be awarded in June 2022 to selected outstanding students of Chinese descent who are graduating from high schools in San Diego County.

Two types of scholarships are available, based upon the post-secondary degree sought:

- A one-time \$1,500 scholarship for use at a four-year university or college toward a baccalaureate degree (BA or BS)
- A one-time \$1,000 scholarship for use at a two-year community college or vocational program toward an associate degree (AA or AS) or certificate

The total number of scholarships to be awarded will depend on availability of funding and the number of deserving applicants.

SECTION II - ELIGIBILITY

Open to both male and female students, applicants must be:

- A. at least one-quarter Chinese descent; and,
- B. graduating from a San Diego County high school no later than end of academic year 2021-2022 (typically, June 2022); and,
- C. If applying for the \$1,500 four-year university/college scholarship:
 - Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5/weighted; and, have immediate plans for attendance at a four-year university or college.

or,

- D. If applying for the \$1,000 community college/vocational program scholarship:
 - Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5; and, have immediate plans for attendance at a two-year community college or vocational program.

SECTION III – SUBMISSION

1. Application Form

Complete the Application Form on page 4 of this document. All submissions must be in English.

2. Extracurricular Activities (length: maximum one page, typed and double-spaced)

On a page separate from the Application Form, describe one to three activities in which you participate. Examples may include, but are not limited to, school activities, volunteerism outside of school and family responsibilities. If you presently or in the past were employed part-time or full-time, be sure to include it with a brief description of the experience. **DO NOT** include your name on this section.

3. Essay (length: maximum two pages, typed and double-spaced)

On pages separate from the Application Form, respond to the following prompt:

ESSAY TOPIC: Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) hate is on the rise. As you prepare to go to college, what measures will you take to proactively counteract this rising threat for your personal well-being as well as for the greater good of the Asian community and society at-large while keeping your hopes and dreams alive?

DO NOT include your name on this section.

4. Letter of Recommendation

Submit one personal recommendation letter from a teacher, school counselor, principal, mentor or employer. The recommendation can describe your character, interpersonal relationships, skills/talents or other reasons why you deserve the scholarship. The person making the recommendation must include his/her name, position/title and contact information.

This letter must be submitted SEPARATELY from your application materials and sent directly from the person making the recommendation via email to: SDCWA.10@gmail.com with subject line: SDCWA Scholarship 2022 – Letter of Recommendation.

5. Transcript (NOTE: Due circumstances related to COVID-19, unofficial transcripts will be accepted this year.)

Submit a transcript from your high school(s), which includes your grades from the first semester of your senior year. Inclusion of your SAT/ACT scores is optional.

6. FAFSA Application Please submit a copy of your **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Submission Online Application Confirmation Page.

7. Participation in Chinese Cultural Activities (OPTIONAL)

On a page separate from the Application Form, you may include an optional listing of your involvement in Chinese cultural activities, briefly describing your level of participation. DO NOT include your name on this additional page.

DEADLINE: Your application must be received by **Thursday, March 31, 2022**. Review application guidelines carefully; check that your application is complete and all required material is submitted on time.
