

## **2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKAGE**

### **SECTION I - GENERAL INFORMATION**

Scholarships will be awarded in June 2024 to selected outstanding students of Chinese descent who are graduating from high schools in San Diego County.

Two types of scholarships are available, based upon the post-secondary degree sought:

- A one-time \$1,500 scholarship for use at a four-year university or college toward a baccalaureate degree (BA or BS)
- A one-time \$1,000 scholarship for use at a two-year community college or vocational program toward an associate degree (AA or AS) or certificate

The total number of scholarships to be awarded will depend on availability of funding and the number of deserving applicants.

#### **SECTION II - ELIGIBILITY**

Open to both male and female students, applicants must be:

- A. at least one-quarter Chinese descent; and,
- B. graduating from a San Diego County high school no later than end of academic year 2023-2024 (typically, June 2024); and,
- C. If applying for the \$1,500 four-year university/college scholarship:
  - Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5/weighted; <u>and</u>, have immediate plans for attendance at a four-year university or college.
  - Or, if applying for the \$1,000 community college/vocational program scholarship:
    - Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5/weighted; <u>and</u>, have immediate plans for attendance at a two-year community college or vocational program.



## **SECTION III - SUBMISSION**

#### **1. Application Form**

Complete the Application Form on page 5 of this document. All submissions must be in English.

#### 2. Extracurricular Activities

On a page <u>separate</u> from the Application Form, describe your participation in any of the following forms of extracurricular activities. Please explain if there are any extenuating circumstances such as employment or family duties and responsibilities that prevented your involvement in any of these activities.

- Chinese Cultural Activities
- Sports
- Volunteer Involvement
- Any Other Extracurricular Activities

DO NOT include your name on this section.

#### 3. Essay (length: maximum two pages, typed and double-spaced)

On pages <u>separate</u> from the Application Form, respond to the following prompt:

#### ESSAY TOPIC: The mission of the San Diego Chinese Women's Association:

- To promote public awareness, understanding, and appreciation of the Chinese culture, including Chinese history, art, literature, customs, and traditions
- To assist and support other charitable organizations which provide relief and services to the Chinese community in particular, and to other groups as the membership decides
- To encourage the pursuit of higher education by members of the Chinese community through scholarship awards

**Essay Description** – How has your academic and personal journey embodied the SDCWA mission? Please provide specific examples in your essay.

DO NOT include your name on this section.



## 4. Letter of Recommendation

Submit one personal recommendation letter from a teacher, school counselor, principal, mentor or employer. The recommendation can describe your character, interpersonal relationships, skills/talents or other reasons why you deserve the scholarship. The person making the recommendation must include his/her name, position/title and contact information.

This letter must be submitted SEPARATELY from your application materials and <u>sent</u> <u>directly from the person making the recommendation</u> via email to: <u>SDCWA.10@gmail.com</u> with subject line: SDCWA Scholarship 2024 – Letter of Recommendation.

## 5. Official High School Transcript

Submit an official transcript from your high school(s), which includes your grades from the first semester of your senior year. Inclusion of SAT/ACT scores is <u>optional</u>.

## 6. Additional Questions (OPTIONAL)

On a page separate from the Application Form, please answer these questions.

- 1. Are there extenuating financial challenges that you will face while attending college?
- 2. What measures have you taken to address your financial challenges?

## 7. FAFSA Student Aid Report (OPTIONAL)

Please submit a copy of your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Student Aid Report showing the Student Aid Index (SAI) value.

## 8. Permission to Release Identity

Complete and sign the form on page 6 of this document.
